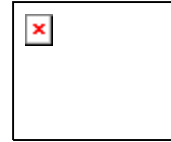

PARENT CONSULTATION EVENINGS

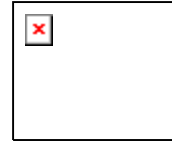
