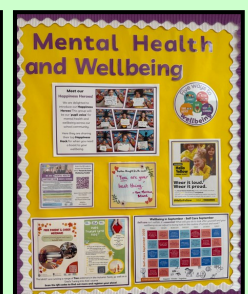
### World Mental Day 2025
