This week, our attendance is **94%**. Last week : **93.65%** (Thurs to Thurs).

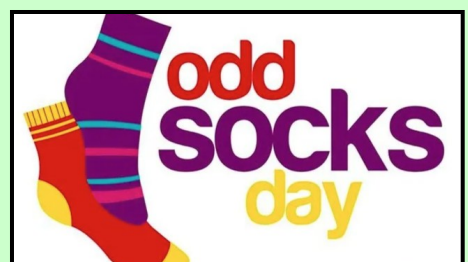


Willow Class Parents' Evening
