Here are a few simple and fun ideas to inspire you:

- **Sparkle** – Glittery clothes, stars, sequins
- **Adventure** – Explorer outfit, map, binoculars
- **Joy** – Bright colours, smiley faces, balloons
- **Sleepy** – Pyjamas and slippers
- **Sporty** – PE kit and medal
- **Nature** – Leaves, flowers, animal accessories
- **Kindness** – Heart shapes and positive words
- **Gigantic** – Oversized clothes or props
- **Explosion** – Red, orange and yellow paper “flames”
- **Stormy** – Grey clothing with cotton wool clouds and raindrops
- **Mysterious** – Dark clothing, magnifying glass, question marks



Please remember, there is absolutely **no** expectation to buy anything new; a label with the chosen word and a few creative touches is all that is needed. The aim is to celebrate **vocabulary, imagination, and the joy of books!**

- **Frozen** – Icy colours, snowflakes
- **Fiery** – Red/orange clothes with flame shapes
- **Rainbow** – Bright multicoloured outfit
- **Ancient** – Roman soldier, Egyptian theme
- **Future** – Silver/robot-style clothing
- **Camouflage** – Army print or leafy disguise
- **Underwater** – Blue clothing, fish or bubbles
- **Jungle** – Animal print, explorer hat
- **Royal** – Crown and cape
- **Grumpy** – Pyjamas, messy hair, crossed arms
- **Cheerful** – Yellow outfit and sunshine
- **Lightning** – Zig-zag bolt shapes
- **Bubbly** – Balloons attached to clothing
- **Shiny** – Foil, metallic colours
- **Windy** – Streamers blowing from sleeves
- **Spooky** – Ghostly whites or dark cloak
