Headteacher's message

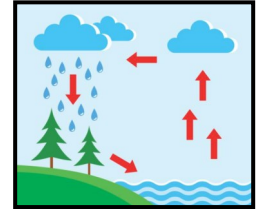
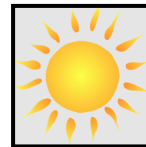

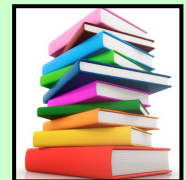
