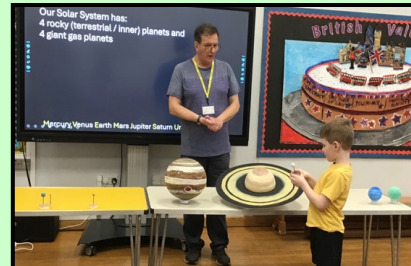
British Science Week at Evercreech!

One of the highlights was a fascinating space talk from a visiting speaker who shared their knowledge about planets and galaxies.
